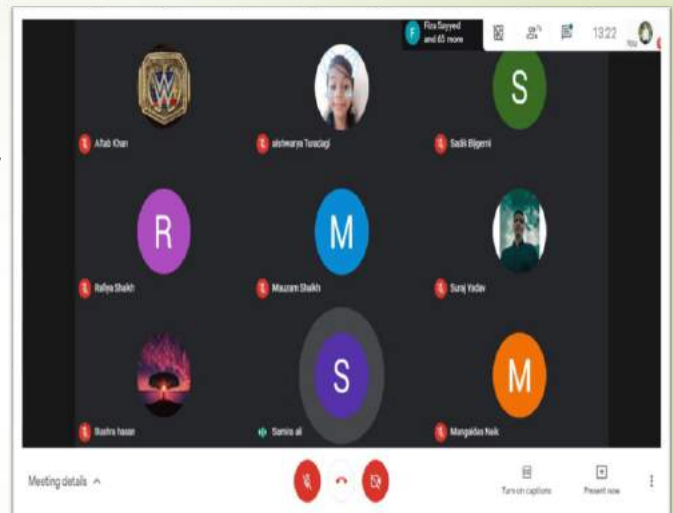
When Dr.Lohia arrived in margao he was greeted with slogans "Jai Hind"but he was arrested and taken to margao police station, the people then flocked in large numbers at the police station shouting slogans, in this movement women also participated and Vatsala kirtani was the first goan women to be arrested for raising the slogan of "Jai Hind"the young groans who protested were arrested and given an inhumane treatment. 18th june was later commemorated as Goa Revolutionary Day.



18th June 2020 Goa revolutionery day was observed through virtual mode. Students were breif by the teachers through vertual mode. A digital wallpepar was developed by headmistress and sent in groups.

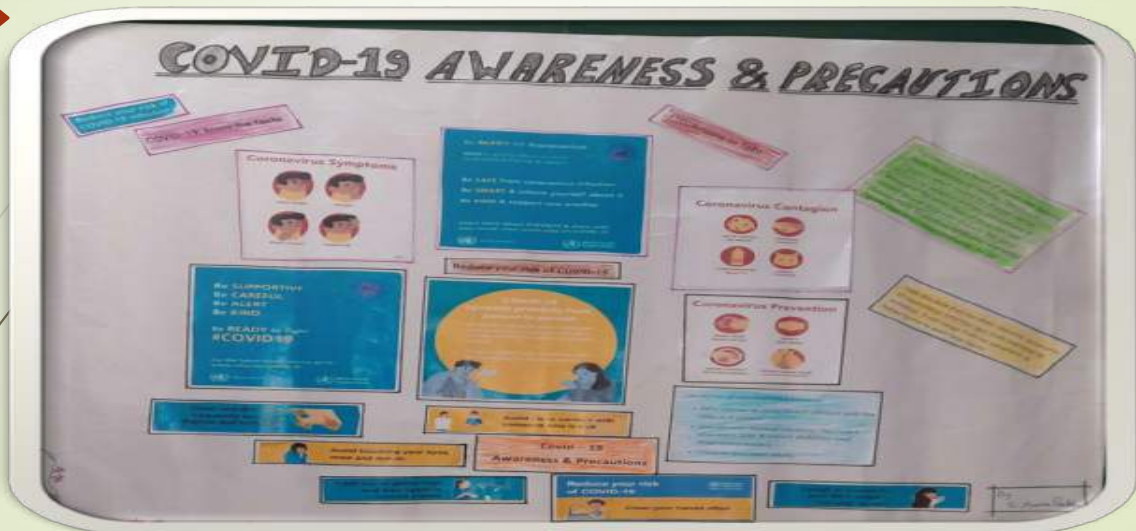


Hindi Diwas

World Students Day Celebration



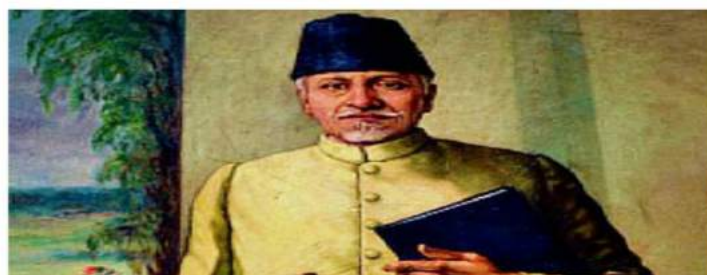
- ❖ World students day was celebrated on 15th October 2020 via online mode to mark the birth anniversary of our great leader A.P.J. Abdul Kalam.

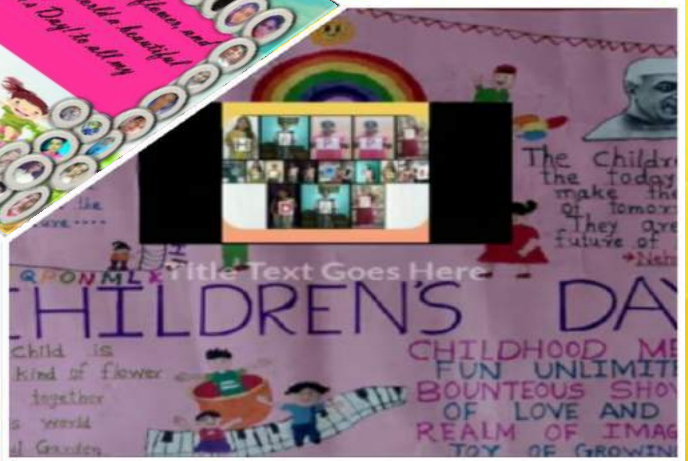

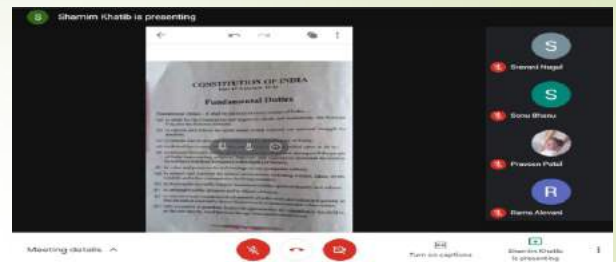


Constitutional Day Celebration

Kala Utsav



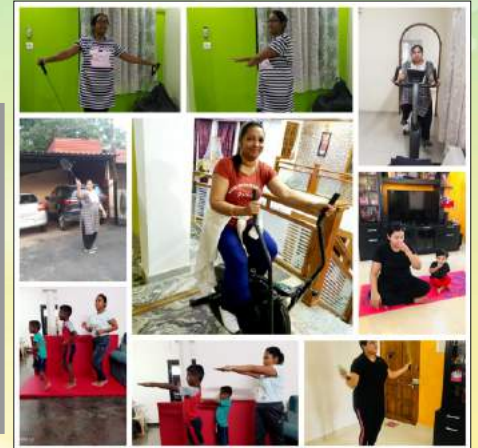

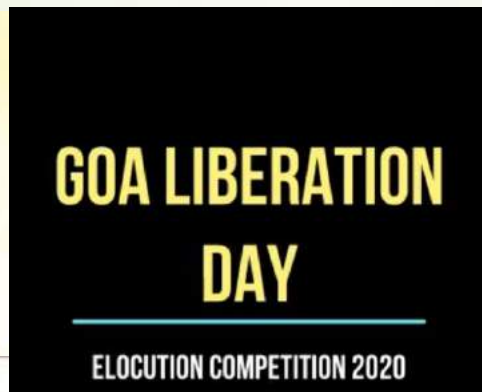
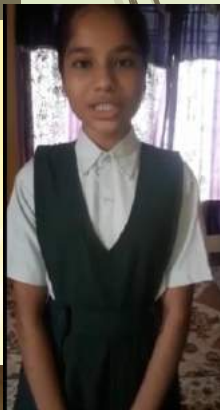

Other students also displayed signboards on bad effect of tobacco. Lastly, Tr. Maria made the students aware about harmful effects of consuming tobacco.

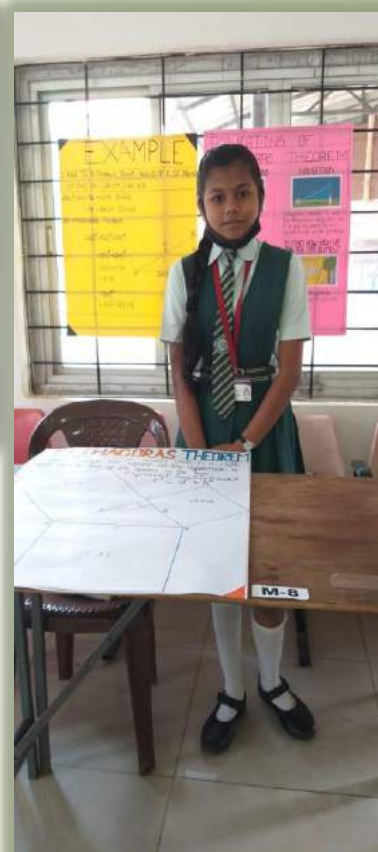


Science Centre Miramar

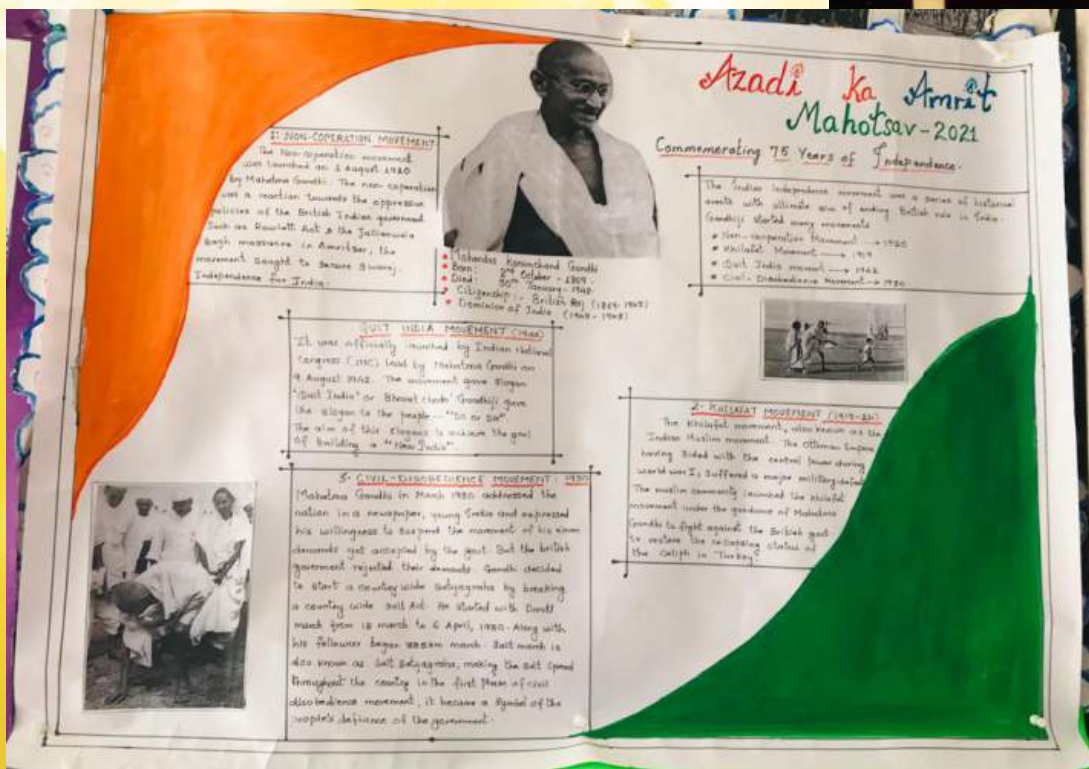

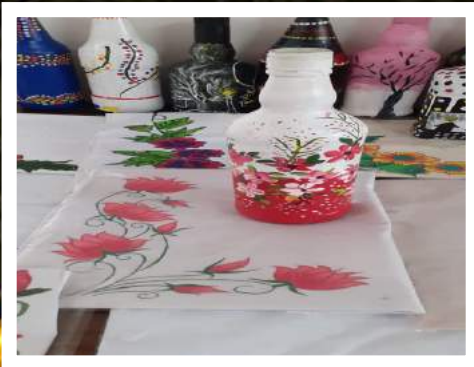
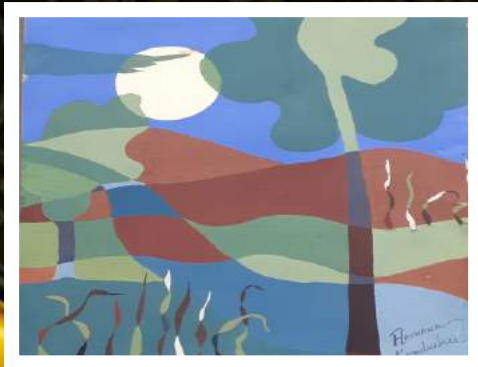
